I started making these, as with most things, because of my own use and not being happy enough with what I had. After the Seat going hard on a \$3200 Saddle that I purchased at Equitana, I cut it open and found Foam, sprayed on out of a Can.

It is no surprise then that mine has 'High Density Neoprene' beneath it.

POSITION

It has been a fact, across the History of the Australian Stock Saddle that they have and most still do:

- put Riders' in the 'Arm Chair' Position
- with the Legs out the front
- weight to the back of the Horse
- terrible riding position, teaching incorrect Riding into the future
- no 'Independent Seat'
- no 'Centred and Balanced Riding' and

- **HANGING** off the Mouths of the Horses as the Rider struggles to **PULL THEMSELVES UP** because their Legs are out the front. All bad.
